### What's going on in the science lab?



Frog dissections are still standard fare for the middle school science class. In 7th grade at Nativity, the learning objectives include:

- Being able to explain why humans dissect animals and why a frog is a useful animal for dissection
- Being able to ID basic dissection tools
- Describing the function of each of the organs of the nervous, skeletal, respiratory, circulatory, reproductive, muscular, and excretory systems

- Dissecting the frog safely, respectfully, and precisely
- Identifying and illustrating organs
- Describing the organs and the organ system functions
- Writing a 2-4 paragraph description of either the digestive, respiratory, or circulatory system
