

THE SCHOOL PROVIDES A CHALLENGING AND SUPPORTIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT, WHERE MOTIVATED STUDENTS OF ALL FAITHS ARE OFFERED AN INTELLECTUAL, CULTURAL, PHYSICAL AND MORAL EDUCATION. THE GOAL IS TO GRADUATE YOUNG MEN WHO ARE ACADEMICALLY PREPARED FOR FURTHER EDUCATION, INSPIRED TO LEAD THEIR LIVES WITH HUMILITY, AND DEDICATED TO SERVING OTHERS.



MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD CHAIR AND HEAD OF SCHOOL

Dear Friends,

The 2019-20 academic year at Nativity Prep began like most, but ended like no other in modern memory. As the pandemic hit Massachusetts, in response to state and local mandates the school closed its doors on March 13, 2020 to the in-person classes that parents, students, teachers had assumed were a constant feature of our educational model. Overnight, remote learning went from being a little-understood technology to a requirement for student learning. The pandemic brought a tragic loss of life, perpetual anxiety, massive economic hardship for many people, and a complete disruption of everyday life. In the spheres of education and human development, the effects have been far-reaching. From learning loss and stifled academic growth to social-emotional struggles and loneliness, being out of school exacerbated difficulties faced by many kids and families.

But the Nativity community responded in ways that did not surprise us. Trustees and other donors responded by providing funds so that every student would have a Chromebook and every teacher would have the necessary technology and training to make this new remote learning model possible. Students and their parents showed determination and resilience in the face of these trying new circumstances. Teachers showed creativity and a willingness to devote extraordinary time and effort to adapt teaching plans to this very different format. Administrators worked diligently to keep up with the ever-changing health crisis, to continue progress on building improvement projects, and to support parents, students, and teachers as this major transition took shape.

So, it is with a very special sense of pride and gratitude that we present this annual report of Nativity Preparatory School of New Bedford. Our 2019-20 fiscal year was one like no other, a year of great challenge, a year when the Nativity spirit was tested and found to be strong and resilient, a year when our fundamental educational mission was affirmed despite the fear and uncertainty that the pandemic carried to 66 Spring Street.

We thank you for your generous support throughout this year of crisis and change, and look forward to the day when we can invite you to come and see the exciting things happening at the school and to meet our students as well as the teachers, staff, volunteers and parents who give life to the Nativity Prep mission each and every day, **building our community, one boy at a time.**






LONG LE




